III. Health Protocol

○ **Pre-Arrival**

To comply with Indonesia's COVID-19 health and safety standard, all delegation are required to have travel insurance with COVID-19 coverage. Delegates must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19, proven by a COVID-19 vaccination certificate. If any delegate cannot get a full dose of vaccine due to comorbidity or other health reasons, the delegate must be enclosed with an official health declaration form explaining such condition from Health Officials. All delegation must authenticate their vaccination certificate.

○ **Arrival**

1. All delegates who will enter the territory of the Republic of Indonesia shall adjust their travel documents to ensure compliance with the provisions regarding the foreign travelers allowed to enter the territory of Indonesia, which includes COVID-19 vaccination certificates
2. All delegates are allowed to enter the territory of Indonesia through entry points via Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, Jakarta. Please note that The Committee only provides G20 hospitality airport arrival in Soekarno-Hatta, Jakarta.
3. Upon arrival at the entry points, delegates must undergo a COVID-19 symptom check, including a body temperature check, with the following conditions:
 - a. If there is no symptom of COVID-19 and body temperature is below 37.5 degrees Celsius: no need to undergo RT-PCR examination upon arrival
 - b. If there is no symptom of COVID-19 and body temperature is above 37.5 degrees Celsius: must undergo RT-PCR examination upon arrival



4. The provision regarding the period of isolation (quarantine) applies for all foreign travelers with the following categories:
 - a. Quarantine is no longer required for those who have received the complete dose of vaccine at least 14 days before the departure time.
 - b. Quarantine period of 5x24 hours is required for those who have not been vaccinated or received the complete dose of vaccine
 - c. Foreign travelers under the age of 18 (eighteen) years and/or require special protection can follow the quarantine period provisions imposed on their parents or caregivers.
5. The above policies are temporary and will be readjusted according to global health and national policies development.

○ **During Meeting**

To ensure the safety of all delegates, all meetings and site events' arrangement will follow physical distancing protocol. All delegates are expected to follow all arranged by the Indonesian G20 Presidency. **Any changes with the health protocol policy will be promptly informed to all delegates in writing through email.**

○ **Pre-Departure**

Delegates who might need PCR test for departure requirement, there is the following recommended place:

IV. Registration

Delegates are required to fill the registration form through link below to provide an ID Card to recognized as the delegation on the venue. Any update must be made five days prior to arrival.

There will be a Liaison Officer (LO) during your arrival in the airport. The LO will guide the delegations to the transportation shelter in the airport to the venue of the workshop.

There are two choices for public transportations, i.e.: taxis and bus are available at the airport. The cost for taxi service from airport to the venue is approximately IDR 500.000-1.000.000 (USD 35-70). The bus (DAMRI) from airport to the venue will cost approximately IDR 80.000 – 150.000 (USD 6-10).





○ ID Card

Each accredited delegate will be given ID Card / badge corresponding to their category. ID Card must be worn during the meeting allowing delegates to access venues. ID Card will be assigned to delegates who are listed on the registration form and non-transferable. ID Card will be given upon the delegations arrival on 3 August 2022.





VI. Visa Application

Delegates can use either diplomatic, service passports or ordinary /business passports to enter Indonesia. The Indonesian government has a short visit visa-free agreement with several countries for diplomatic and service passport holders. The list of Agreements on Mutual Visa Exemption between the Republic of Indonesia and Foreign Countries can be found in (<http://kem.lu/visaddservice>)

- Delegates with nationalities from countries that are written on the list can enter Indonesia without a visa using a diplomatic and service passport. These delegates must bring the approved delegation **accreditation letter** from G20 Indonesia Presidency c/q Ministry of Agriculture, travel insurance document covering COVID-19, and exhibit vaccination certificate
- Delegates from countries which written or not written on the Mutual Visa Exemption List and using ordinary passport holders must apply visa and must include the **accreditation letter** in their visa application. Delegates are strongly advised to apply early from the Embassies and Consulates of the Republic of Indonesia accredits to or stationed in the respective member countries. 

○ **Customs**

Indonesian national laws govern the importation and exportation of prohibited or controlled items into or out of Indonesia, including medications. Delegates are allowed to bring medication, strictly for personal use. However, drugs containing narcotics are prohibited from entering Indonesia. Those containing psychotropic substances are restricted and must be declared. In addition, delegates must present a letter from their physician and/or a copy of the original prescription stating the list of medication(s) and amount used per day to a custom officer. These documents are essential to prove the legality of prescribed medication, should there be questioning by the customs. The government exempts some excisable goods purchased abroad for personal use from import duties, excise, and taxes for every adult on every arrival with a limited amount:

- 18 years old or above: 200 cigarettes, 25 cigars, or 100 grams of sliced tobacco or other tobacco product, and/or
- 21 years old or above: 1 liter of alcoholic beverages. Any excess of the excisable goods will be destroyed.

Non-resident carrying more than USD 10,000 (or equivalent in other foreign currencies) or IDR 100,000,000 in cash should be declared to the Customs.



X. City Information

○ About Bogor

Bogor is a pleasant town, and home to Indonesia's Agricultural University and the Zoological Museum. Bogor, is famous with its botanical garden. The world-famous Bogor Botanical Garden borders the Palace Grounds, covering an area of 87 hectares with thousands of species of plant life from all over the world.

○ Health and Safety

Bogor has excellent hospitals and high-quality medical care available 24-hours a day.

○ Weather

Bogor lies at the foothills of Mount Salak. It has high, year-round rainfall, and a much cooler climate compared to metropolitan Jakarta.

○ Currency

Bogor's currency name is **Indonesian Rupiah** and is abbreviated as Rp. The currency code is IDR, which is Indonesian Rupiah.

○ Electricity

Most power plugs and sockets in Indonesia are type C and F. This plug is the 2 pin socket and plug design which is the standard European plug.





XI. Additional Information

○ **Dress Code**

The dress code is business attire. Long sleeve Batik shirts for men and long sleeve batik dresses are also considered as business attire in Indonesia.

○ **Working Language**

All meetings will be conducted in English. No interpretation services will be provided.

○ **International Dialing Code**

Indonesia's country code is +62, and Bogor's local code is 251. Therefore, to call a local number, you can dial +62 followed by 251 and then dial the number you wish. Likewise, to call a mobile number using a foreign number, you should dial +62 followed by the mobile number you wish to contact.

Delegates intending to use an Indonesian SIM Card can obtain from an official mobile network operator outlet to have 90-day access.
