


# What is the ePhyto system?

- "ePhyto" is short for electronic phytosanitary certificate.
- It is a digital equivalent of a phytosanitary certificate that allows governments to confirm shipments of plants and plant products are free from pests and disease.

 ePhytos are exchanged through a centralised Hub.




## Benefits of the ePhyto system

### ePhytos have a harmonized and standardized format, structure, and codes

- Improvements in security
- Reduction in trade costs
- Creates significant time efficiencies during border processing
- Global coverage with one system
- Supports developing countries to engage in efficient trade with other countries
- Supports countries to meet international obligations related to trade (ISPM 12 (Annex 1) & Articles 7.9 and 10.1 of the Trade Facilitation Agreement of the WTO).



# Implementation of the ePhyto system

- Currently, 105 countries are registered and 62 countries are using ePhytos as business as usual.
- Case studies report:
  - Average of 4 days of time saved
  - Low-cost to set up
  - Reduced labor costs for exporters
  - No need for special security paper
  - Effective use of resources at border stations
  - Total reduction in fraudulent certificates
  - Access costs for developing countries covered
  - Facilitates the collection of reliable trade statistics
